Day 1

Atlanta, Georgia

Arrive in the capital of the Peach Tree State, famous for its links with Margaret Mitchell's classic *Gone With the Wind* (you'll enjoy the Road to Tara Museum). Atlanta rose from the ashes of the Civil War to become a commercial and financial giant of the Southeast. Visit the Carter Presidential Center, the World of Coca Cola Pavilion or tour the CNN Center, home of the world's largest TV network.

Explore Underground Atlanta for great jazz, or enjoy Southern hospitality at one of the city's great restaurants.

Days 2

To Chattanooga, Tennessee (114 mi/182 km)

Travel north today, into the Appalachian Mountains to Chattanooga. Incorporated in 1851, the city began as an outpost on the border of the Cherokee Nation and developed into a diverse city with a variety of manufacturing, commercial and cultural activities. Along the way, the city also saw action in two Civil War battles. Don't miss the Tennessee Aquarium, Ruby Falls and the Chattanooga Choo Choo!

Days 3, 4

To Memphis, Tennessee (317 mi/507 km)

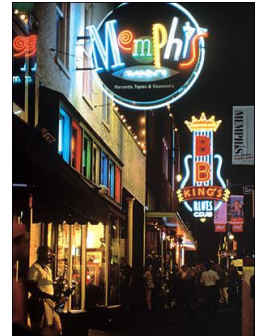
Welcome to the home of the blues, Beale Street, W.C. Handy and Elvis Presley.

"The Mountain Top" sculpture, honours Dr Martin Luther King, who was assassinated here. Mud Island, a 52-acre park showcases the mighty Mississippi River.

Days 5, 6

To Nashville, Tennessee (210 mi/336 km)

Drive to the home of Country Music. Visit the homes and museums of music giants, visit the Country Music Hall of Fame. Sail aboard the General Jackson Showboat on the Cumberland River.

Select: Millennium Maxwell

Day 7

To the Great Smoky Mountains, North Carolina (293 mi/469 km)

In Chimney Rock Park, reach the top of legendary Chimney Rock for a spectacular view (reach the summit via a 26-story elevator inside the mountain!). Explore the park's nature trails, 404-foot waterfall, cave and rare plant life.

Days 8

To Raleigh, North Carolina (246 mi/394 km)

Travel to Raleigh, the cultural and educational centre of North Carolina.

Day 9, 10 To Cape Fear, North Carolina (120 mi/192 km)
 Continue southward, exploring the beautiful towns of the Low Country. Arrive in Wilmington and enjoy the coast, explore the historic Cotton Exchange or relax on the beach.
Hotel: 2 nights Cape Fear.
 Standard: Comfort Inn Wilmington
 Select: Hilton Wilmington Riverside

Day 11, 12 To Charleston, South Carolina (166 mi/266 km)
 Travel south to Myrtle Beach with its variety of entertainment and spectacular beaches. Discover Charleston, one of the South's best preserved cities with blocks of restored historic structures. Stroll through Magnolia Plantation and Gardens, explore the 30-acre Audubon Swamp Gardens or take a cruise to Fort Sumter, where the Civil War began. Visit one of the magnificent plantations nearby, walk or bicycle through over 500 acres of wildlife trails.

Day 13, 14 To Savannah, Georgia (110 mi/176 km)
 Arrive in romantic Savannah, founded in 1733 as Britain's last colony. Explore the restored waterfront. Many of Savannah's old buildings have survived and been restored including the Pirates' House (1754), an old seaman's inn mentioned in Stevenson's Treasure Island; the Herb House (1734), the oldest existing building in Georgia, and the Pink House (1789), site of Georgia's first bank. The Telfair Academy of Arts and Sciences opened in Savannah as one of the South's first public museums.
Hotel: 2 nights Savannah
 Standard: La Quinta Inn
 Select: River Street Inn

Day 15 To Atlanta, Georgia (249 mi/398 km)
 Drive along the Antebellum Trail, through Macon, famous for its plantation style homes, en route to Atlanta where the tour ends.

This tour may be commenced in Memphis.
